

Dormitory Information for International Students

Every dorm room is air-conditioned and fully furnished with beds and mattresses, study desks and chairs, and wardrobes. Private bathroom with water heater is located inside each room. Free wifi access throughout the building. The maximum occupancy is 2 students per room. Coin-operated washing machines are available only in the female dormitories. Restaurants and minimarts are situated within the dormitory areas.

Room Deposit:

- All new students must pay a deposit before moving into the dormitory.
 - 1 student per room: 6,000 baht/room
 - 2 students per room: 3,000 baht/person
- After moving out of the dormitory, the deposit will be returned. However, if there are any damages to the inventory and/or dormitory room, the deposit will not be returned.

Room Rates (excluding utilities fee):

- Daily rate at 500 baht/room/day
- Monthly rate:
 - 1 student per room: 5,000 baht/person/month
 - 2 students per room: 2,500 baht/person/month
- Semesterly (6 months) rate:
 - 1 student per room: 27,000 baht/person/semester
 - 2 students per room: 13,500 baht/person/semester

Remarks: If you waive your stay after payment has been made, the dormitory will not refund the money you have paid. Move out notice should be made 30 days in advance.

Utilities Rates:

The utilities fee will be charged separately every month and calculated on usage of each room:

- Electricity fee is 7.49 baht/unit
- Water fee is 18.19 baht/unit

Payment Process:

1. Get the pay-in slip for room/deposit payment.
2. Go to Siam Commercial Bank (SCB) and transfer the payment on time.
3. Submit original transaction receipt to the Dormitory Office as proof of payment.

Required Documents for Check-In:

1. Two copies of your passport
2. Two student photos (size 1 inch)

PSU Phuket Dormitory Rules

You Must:

- ✓ Respect the rights and interests of other students.
- ✓ Show the Dormitory Card to the Security staff upon entering and leaving.

- ✓ Take care of the dormitory inventory.

You are Not Allowed:

- ✓ To smoke.
- ✓ To drink, make, and/or distribute alcoholic beverages and/or drugs.
- ✓ To let in and/or host unregistered guests.
- ✓ To be extremely loud.
- ✓ To use explosives.
- ✓ To leave domestic waste, dirty dishes, or personal inventory from one's room in the shared areas.
- ✓ To leave your shoes, belongings, and/or garbage in front of your dormitory room.
- ✓ To keep pets.
- ✓ To move to another room without permission.
- ✓ To damage the dormitory inventory or dormitory area.
- ✓ To move out of the dormitory without informing the Dormitory Administrator.
- ✓ To make any repairs to the dormitory premises or inventory without the approval of the staff.
- ✓ To use the dormitory area for economic and commercial activities.
- ✓ To disrespect, threaten, or insult the employees of the dormitory and/or the students.
